

M. Sc. Scholar Stipends in Support of International Publication

The Research School of Environmental Chemistry, Microbiology, and Toxicology (RECETO) is pleased to announce a number of scholar stipends of DKK 30,000 each for outstanding M. Sc. students who will complete their thesis work at a RECETO institution with the submission of a peer-reviewed research paper to an international journal.

The purpose is to ensure that noteworthy M. Sc. research in environmental chemistry, microbiology, and toxicology is communicated to the international scientific community and to help prepare the most talented M. Sc. students for Ph. D. studies.

Students must apply for the scholar stipend at least two months before they complete their M. Sc. thesis. Applicants will receive word about the stipend about one month after submission of their application.

The application must include:

- A completed application form
 - See <http://www.receto.dk/Vacancies-and-Scholarships/Application-forms.aspx>
- Two A4 pages with the following:
 - A description of the work that is to be published, including objectives, background, methods, and anticipated results.
 - The title of paper and the journal to which it will be submitted.
 - Ten key literature references
 - A time schedule
- The student's Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- Copies of the student's B. Sc. and M. Sc. study credits and course marks
- A statement from the student's current supervisor about the standing of the student and the quality and feasibility of the M. Sc. project.

Students who are awarded a scholar stipend in support of international publication must acknowledge RECETO in the research paper and send a copy of the published paper to the RECETO secretariat.

Note: The RECETO scholar stipend cannot be awarded to students who have received a scholar stipend from another source.
